It has come to our attention that there is an agenda item , File # 26-00054, submitted by the Sheriff's Office and General Services to renew the Enterprise Fleet Management program begun in 2021. While we appreciate the savings garnered for Santa Barbara County, we have a current issues to address with Enterprise.

It has been reported to us that ICE has rented over 1,000 vehicles from Enterprise so they may carry out their actions in Minnesota. They have even canceled current car rental reservations to consumers ahead of ICE arriving in Minnesota, particularly reservations for vans and SUV vehicles. Local organizations in Minnesota are terminating their leasing contracts with Enterprise due to the ICE connection.

While is it obvious the Santa Barbara has gained savings from the Enterprise Fleet Management program, it would be beneficial to our County citizens to show support for this boycott favoring ICE over residents.

At a minimum, it is requested that you discuss this with our Sheriff and General Services Department on record. The local Enterprise services may be able to assure you in writing that they will not be leasing to ICE in support of both your stance and that of the State of California's stance on ICE raids. Another immediate option is postponement of the contract renewal until the local Enterprise can weigh in on this important issue.

Minneapolis Enterprise is knowingly supporting the raids in Minneapolis. However, If our local Enterprise can resist ICE leases and support our community, it is a good corporate and county partnership of our tax funds. Thank you for concern for this issue.
