Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Authorize the Chair to execute the attached Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Ardalan Construction, Inc. for Phase IB of the Clerk Recorder Assessor Election Division Consolidation Project (Project #8685) located at 4440 Calle Real, Santa Barbara, in the amount of \$42,638 for a total amended contract amount of \$134,138.
- B. Re-authorize the Director of General Services or his designee to approve additional changes to the contract of an amount not to exceed 10% of the original contract amount, or \$9,150 for this contract.

Summary Text:

The County of Santa Barbara entered into a contract in the amount of \$91,500 with Ardalan Construction, Inc. on January 5, 2010 to perform maintenance alterations to 6,000 square feet of the lower level of the County-owned building located at 4440 Calle Real in Santa Barbara, including removal of non-load bearing walls, flooring replacement, paint, and electrical and data wiring.

Amendment No. 1 will modify the contract with Ardalan Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$42,638 to provide for architectural, electrical, plumbing, flooring and ceiling revisions necessitated in the majority by unforeseen conditions. Amendment No. 1 will not increase the over project budget.

Background:

The Veterans Administration Building located at 4440 Calle Real, Santa Barbara, is a 24,000 square foot county owned facility built in 1967 on the Calle Real Campus. In 2005 the US Federal Veteran's Administration vacated all but approximately 6,000sf on the upper level of the building, and continues to serve as an outpatient clinic. Since that time most of the building has remained vacant and several options have been studied for how best to use the building including possible use as an interim Emergency Operations Center (EOC). It was subsequently determined that the space would adequately serve the needs of the Clerk Recorder Assessor's (CRA) Elections Division and allow consolidation of staff and operations presently housed within 3 different facilities including leased space.

The consolidation project for CRA Elections Division is comprised of two construction phases, Phases I and II, with Phase I encompassing two sub phases, Phases IA and IB. Phases IA and IBs project costs total \$500,000, and Phase II project costs are estimated to cost \$1,100,000, for an overall project cost of \$1,600,000, which is consistent with the CaLease loan amount approved by the Board on September 15, 2009. Phase IA of this project was completed in 2009 and accomplished repairs to the existing space within the Veteran's Clinic to allow it to serve as a ballot storage room including removal of built in casework, addition of an FM-200 fire suppression system, and general maintenance. Phase II will repair the remainder of available square footage on the 1st floor of the Vets (approximately 6,000sf), and approximately 6,000sf of the 2nd floor, and will also prepare the building for the installation of an emergency generator automatic transfer switch, installation of a card reader access system, a security camera system and relocation of the existing server.

On January 5, 2010, the County of Santa Barbara entered into a construction contract in the amount of \$91,500 with Ardalan Construction, Inc. to perform Phase IB of the project, the subject of the recommended Board action herein. This phase involves repairs to the northern 6,000sf of the lower level of the building including carpet replacement, demolition of select non-load bearing partitions, paint, and distribution of data and telephone to serve as the county's Vote by Mail Processing facility (note: In the past this function was performed in leased space at an annual cost of about \$200,000/year). This Amendment No. 1 to the construction contract will amend the contract in the amount of \$42,638, for a total contract amount of \$134,148 and will allow for added flooring due to asbestos abatement, revised wall framing and plumbing due to active water lines running to upper floor and removal of hallway drinking fountain, additional electrical work for revised modular furniture plan and added outlets, related finish work, and installation of new ceiling tiles.

Amendment No.1, while increasing the amount of the construction contract for Phase IB with Ardalan Construction, Inc., will not increase the overall project budget for Phases I and II of project since the construction bids for both Phases I and II came in significantly below the original construction estimates. The overall budget for project Phases I and II remains at \$1,600,000.

Narrative:

The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$1,600,000, including construction and related soft costs for Phases IA, IB and II. Phase II is estimated to cost \$1,100,000, and Phases IA and IB are estimated to cost \$500,000. All project phases are budgeted, with \$704,350 of the funds being available in Fund 0030 Department 063, Account 8700, Program 1930, Project 8685, and the remaining \$895,650 in funds being available as deposited with the Trustee as selected by the Clerk Recorder Assessor. On July 30, 2009, the Debt Advisory Committee (DAC) unanimously recommended that the Board of Supervisors consider financing Phase II of the project, with the annual payment being no more than the current payment being made for Election's space. The CaLease loan documents were approved by the Board on September 15, 2009, and proceeds were confirmed on deposit with the Trustee on December 3, 2009.

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara (COUNTY) and ARDALAN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. (CONTRACTOR), 1459 Thousand Oaks Blvd., Suite G1, Thousand Oaks, CA 91362, entered into a contract dated January 5, 2010, for the amount of NINETY ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$91,500) for the VA Building Alterations for Elections – Phase 1B, Project Number 8685, Santa Barbara California; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary by the County to make the following alterations known as Amendment No. 1, for a total of FORTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$42,638); and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR will perform the alterations stated in Exhibit "C" and attached hereto, for a total of FORTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$42,638) and a zero (0) calendar day time extension in the contract period.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agreement is amended as follows:

Section 1:

Paragraph 5 of said Contract is hereby amended to read as follows:

5. PAYMENT

Subject to adjustments and liquidated damages, if any, as provided in the Contract documents, the full price to be paid to CONTRACTOR for satisfactory completion of all requirements of CONTRACTOR under the Agreement is the base amount of NINETY ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$91,500), plus Amendment No. 1 for FORTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$42,638), for a total Contract amount of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$134,138) to be paid as provided for in the Contract Documents, i.e., on a monthly basis in an amount directly proportional to the percentage of completion of work. CONTRACTOR shall maintain and make available to COUNTY all books, papers, job descriptions, records, detail costs, estimates, subcontracts, and financial records related to or which arise out of work or under the terms or conditions of the Contract. The form of record keeping shall be subject to approval by COUNTY.

These books, papers, records, claims, and accounts shall be made available for examination during normal business hours by COUNTY or COUNTY's representative and shall be retained at CONTRACTOR's principal place of business in California for audit during normal business at such place for four (4) years after recording of Notice of Completion of Project. CONTRACTOR shall provide an office to enable COUNTY and COUNTY's representative to conduct such audit. Section 2:

Paragraph 2 of the Contract is hereby amended by the addition of the following language:

2. WORK

Items of work to be performed by the CONTRACTOR shall include all items stated in "Exhibit C," incorporated by this reference and attached hereto.

Section 3:

This Amendment, along with the consent of the CONTRACTOR attached hereto, shall constitute a contract between the County and Ardalan Construction Company, Inc. All other sections of the Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.
