**Recommended Actions:** That the Board of Supervisors appropriate \$13,000.00 from the Park Mitigation Fund (1395) for the purchase of an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) for Rancho Guadalupe Dunes.

#### **Summary Text:**

This recommendation is before the Board in order to appropriate \$13,000.00 from the Park Mitigation Fund (1395) for the purchase of an ATV to assist with the Guadalupe Dunes California least tern and Western Snowy Plover monitoring program. This vehicle is only for special use at Guadalupe Dunes Park. In, 2010, Santa Barbara County Parks took over the management of Guadalupe Dunes Park and the Western Snowy Plover monitoring program. Parks is purchasing an ATV at Guadalupe Dunes Park, a location that currently does not have an ATV, in order to access all areas of the Park and more efficiently monitor Western Snowy Plover activity.

#### **Background:**

Rancho Guadalupe Dunes County Park is located in northern Santa Barbara County and encompasses approximately 592 acres. The majority of the property within Guadalupe Dunes is a suitable breeding habitat for snowy plovers and least terns. Guadalupe Dunes Western Snowy Plover monitoring is a federal requirement.
