NOTICE OF CEQA EXEMPTION

Based on a preliminary review of the project the following activity is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as defined in the State and County Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project involves an approximate 2,000 square foot easement to be granted from Leo & Tia Blickely Family Trust, Dated August 2, 2002, to the Santa Barbara Flood Control and Water Conservation District, and an approximate 2,000 square foot easement to be granted from the Santa Barbara Flood Control and Water Conservation District to Leo & Tia Blickely Family Trust, Dated August 2, 2002. The recommendations to the Board of Supervisors include authority to execute Certificates of Acceptance and any other documents to complete this transaction.
