RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 2018 AS ENERGY AWARENESS MONTH IN THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

WHEREAS, the County is an active member of the Santa Barbara County Energy Watch Partnership, which is a partnership between local governments in Santa Barbara County, Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Gas Company; and the cities of Santa Maria, Buellton, Guadalupe, Santa Maria and Solvang; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Maria Valley Chamber of Commerce has served as the Implementer of the Santa Barbara County Energy Watch Partnership since 2008 and the program has assisted municipalities and over 400 businesses in north Santa Barbara County to become more energy efficient; and

WHEREAS, it is more important now than ever to encourage energy efficiency and sustainability for all residents, businesses and municipalities. It is good public policy to conserve energy, empower others to take action, and join together to save energy and money; and

WHEREAS, energy efficiency programs enhance our environment by improving air quality, reducing greenhouse gases and other pollutants, and conserving natural resources; and it is vital for communities to incorporate energy efficiency into everyday business practices and personal lives; and

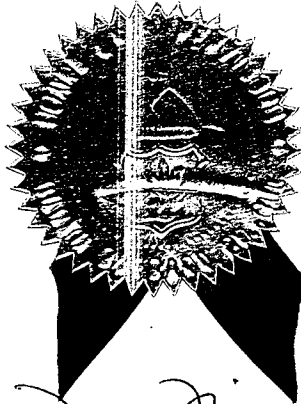
WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County seeks to promote innovative methods and advanced technologies in the design and construction of new residential and commercial buildings within the county; and
