SUBJECT: 03AGP-00000-00027, Wiester Agricultural Preserve Replacement
Contract

Recommendation:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and direct execution and recordation by the Clerk of the Board of new replacement contract 03AGP-00000-00027, replacing a portion of the original Agricultural Preserve 73-AP-042 and 76-AP-013. The replacement contract involves Assessor's Parcel Nos. 083-180-020 (portion of) and 083-180-025 (portion of), located south of Hwy 246 at 8250 and 8620 Santa Rosa Road, in the Buellton area, Third Supervisorial District.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with actions required by law or by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The subject property has been in an agricultural preserves (73-AP-042 and 76-AP-013) since January 1, 1974 and January 1, 1977 respectively. The site is approximately 223 acres and is used for cattle grazing and crops. A lot line adjustment (02LLA-00000-00016) recorded which

modified the boundaries of the existing preserve thus causing the need for the replacement contracts.

Mandates and Service Levels:

Government Code §51200 (known as the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 or the Williamson Act) provides that local jurisdictions may establish an agricultural preserve program having the goal of retaining land in an agricultural use. The County of Santa Barbara has adopted such a program which is codified under the Agricultural Preserve Program Uniform Rules. Both the County's Uniform Rules and the Government Code provide that agricultural preserve contracts between the County and landowners are voluntary. Therefore, there are no state mandates associated with this program.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The costs associated with processing this replacement contract are offset by the \$1,276.00 processing fee required to be paid by the applicant per the Planning & Development adopted fee schedule.
