Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution as follows:

Effective October 2, 2006 add a special duty allowance of \$1,100 per pay period for one Staff Physician II (Class 007103) for providing all on-call emergency medical coverage in the Alcohol, Drug, and Mental Health Services Department (ADMHS) Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF).

Background:

This recommendation addresses the unusual situation of a part-time doctor who takes all of the on-call duty at the PHF outside his normal working hours. The population served at the PHF frequently includes people with serious medical conditions, and state law mandates that a physician be on-call 24 hours per day, 365 days per year to respond to medical emergencies that arise.

Recent restructuring of on-call for doctors on October 2, 2006 did not cover the unusual situation of a single doctor covering all on-call requirements at the PHF. CEO/HR recommends that the Board approve a Special Duty Allowance of \$1,100 per pay period. The proposed Special Duty Allowance will ensure that the physician covering all on-call at the PHF continues to receive the same level of compensation for being on-call that he received before the restructuring.

Fiscal Analysis:

The proposed Special Duty Allowance of approximately \$37,200 annually including rollups presents no increased costs to the County since ADMHS had already budgeted for the costs of providing on-call services in the PHF when the agreement to restructure call was approved by the Board in October 2006.
