Propositions 22 and 26 would have forced local governments to eliminate 45,000-63,000 jobs statewide, and would have severely impacted the State's economic recovery. While AB105 eliminated the threat of Propositions 22 and 26, local governments like the County of Santa Barbara continually face shortfalls and new threats to our transportation funding. The County received our last installment of Proposition 1B Local Streets and Roads funds in 2010. Oil prices are on the rise, construction costs are increasing, and local sales tax revenue has decreased significantly in the last few years. With all of these factors and shortages, our unfunded transportation infrastructure backlog is steadily increasing. In Santa Barbara County alone, our unfunded transportation backlog is approximately \$220 million.

It is imperative that the California State legislature continue to protect transportation funding for local governments, and reject any future bills that further threaten this funding. The County of Santa Barbara is committed to keeping our roads safe, reliable, and accessible to all users. We must reiterate the necessity for your continued support as well as the legislature's to preserve what is already a bare bones revenue stream meeting less than half of annual needs for state and local maintenance and safety improvement projects.
