Project Description: Implementation of CFDs special tax levy for the FY2015-2016. Pursuant to California Government Code section 53340, subdivision (b), each year on or before August 10 the amount of the special tax to be levied on each parcel in the community facilities district for the applicable tax year must be determined, a resolution levying the amounts of the special tax must be adopted, and a certified list of all parcels subject to the special tax levy, including the amount of the tax to be levied on each parcel for the applicable tax year, must filed with the County Auditor.


