WHEREAS, Bill Palladini worked to ensure public officials received and considered feedback from residents of Montecito relating to a number of high profile issues that affected Montecito, including the Tea Fire evacuation and rebuilding efforts, the Miramar, Westmont College Master Plan, Highway 101 widening, and current and future planning oversight along Coast Village Road;
