("Comcast") is duly 9 authorized to operate and maintain a cable communications system (the "System") in 10 Santa Barbara County ("County") pursuant to a franchise (the "Franchise") granted 11 by the County; and 12 WHEREAS, Comcast has requested that the Franchise it holds to 13 provide cable service in the County be renewed; and 14 WHEREAS, the County and Comcast are currently in the Franchise 15 renewal process; and **16** WHEREAS, Comcast Cable Communications, Inc. has given notice of **17** its intention to merge with AT&T Broadband Corporation to form a new entity called 18 AT&T Comcast Corporation (AT&T Comcast); and 19 WHEREAS, Comcast and AT&T Broadband have requested consent by 20 the County to the Transaction as is required by the Franchise prior to any transfer of 21 ownership interest; and 22 WHEREAS, the County has determined that AT&T Comcast will have 23 the requisite legal, technical and financial qualifications to own and operate the Cable 24 System; and 25 NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved:
