

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR FOR
SAFETY WATCH SERVICES PROGRAM**

Third Amendment

This is a *Third Amendment* (Third Amendment to the Agreement) to the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor, number *BC#17-024* by and between the **County of Santa Barbara** (COUNTY) and **Casa Pacifica Centers for Children and Families** (CONTRACTOR).

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2016, the COUNTY approved the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor, BC#17-024, (Agreement) with CONTRACTOR for the provision of Safety Watch Services;

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement commenced on July 1, 2016 and expired on June 30, 2017.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement to extend the initial term of the Agreement for an additional year from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, unless otherwise directed by COUNTY or unless earlier terminated; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the Second Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional year from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, unless otherwise directed by COUNTY or unless earlier terminated; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the Agreement to increase the contract amount for the term from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 and for the term from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows.

The Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Section III., **PERFORMANCE MEASURES/OUTCOMES**, of EXHIBIT A, of the Agreement is amended to state in its entirety:
 - 100% of children who receive Safety Watch Services will be safely stabilized in placement and will not need a higher level of care.
2. Section A of EXHIBIT B of the Agreement is amended to state in its entirety:
 - A. For CONTRACTOR services to be rendered under this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be paid a total contract amount, including cost reimbursements, not to exceed \$ **7,000** for the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017, not to exceed \$ **28,000** for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, and not to exceed \$ **40,000** for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Payment will be made on a reimbursement basis at the rate of \$29.60 per hour for the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017, per client, \$30.49 per hour for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, per client, and \$30.49 per hour for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, per client, for "Safety Watch" Services.

- a. CONTRACTOR is authorized to initiate "Safety Watch" at any time it is deemed advisable, but is required to obtain approval from a Regional Division Chief of County Child Welfare Services for continued use of the protocol in each case at the earliest possible time, and to receive reimbursement for more than 72 hours of Safety Watch service, when authorized. "Safety Watch" is the highest level of the Safety Watch program.

In all other respects, the Agreement remains unchanged and shall remain in full effect.
