Twenty some years ago my wife ~~and~~  
I put together our life savings and purchased  
our dream, a small ranch in Miguelito Canyon.  
This was to be our retreat where we could  
keep our horses and lean on the corral and  
watch the hawks and eagles, surrounded by  
cattle ranches, rolling hills and the tallest  
things were trees, not 500 foot wind turbine.  
Now the county wants to change the Master  
Plan from rural agriculture and open space,  
to a commercial wind turbine farm.

I don't believe there would be many  
if any hawks, eagles or possibly condors  
left alive in the area of this project.  
This project clearly violates the county  
ordinances pertaining ridge lines and property  
line setbacks. If this project is allowed  
it will set precedence and open the gate  
for even more such projects in the area  
and county. Miguelito Canyons future

will be all wind turbines.

Our ranch touches on the eastern boundary of this project and our homesite is within a quarter mile of several of the turbines, and downwind. I could hardly believe it when the impact on our property was mentioned as "insignificant" in the E.I.R. for this project.

I urge you to slow down and take a serious look at this project and the negative impact it will have on the entire Miguelito canyon area and its residents, both people and animals.
