WHEREAS, the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Section 23-11.1, as amended by Ordinance No. 4527, authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the County by Resolution, to designate passenger loading zones; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as passenger loading zones, in accordance with said Section; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following location in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County is hereby designated as a passenger zone from 7 AM to 3 PM school days only:

- A. On the west side of Valencia Road from a point 80 feet north of the centerline of Varley Street to the centerline of Banner Avenue.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to designate said locations with appropriate markings and/or signposts as time and resources permit.
