Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Adopt a CEO/Human Resource Resolution, effective September 8, 2008 to Add Three (3.0) FTE Sheriff's Deputy Trainee/Sheriff's Deputy positions (Class 6904-6905; Range 5572-5972; \$3,907-\$5,822) to the Sheriff's Department;
- 2) Approve Budget Revision Request 2007396 for \$298,750 of additional Court revenue and Sheriff salary expense.

Summary Text:

The recommended actions would increase the number of Sheriff's Deputies assigned to the Court Services Bureau in order to implement a weapons screening program at the Superior Courts in the County. The position will be reimbursed pursuant to the current MOU with the Superior Court of Santa Barbara.

Background:

The Superior Court of Santa Barbara County (Court) is an agency of the State of California, Administrative Office of the Courts. The Presiding Judge of the Court contracts with the Sheriff's Department to provide security to the courts pursuant to Government Code Sections 69920 through 69927.



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The Superior Court of Santa Barbara is the $15^{\rm th}$ largest court system in the State and the largest court system in California without permanent weapons screening stations at any of its courthouses. In recognition of this safety issue, the State Administrative Office of the Courts has provided \$1.8 million in funding for the Court to provide personnel for weapons screening. Additional funding has been earmarked for the purchase of weapons screening equipment through the State.

The Court, in conjunction with the Sheriff's Department, has devised an implementation plan for weapons screening at the courthouses. The ultimate goal is to have permanent weapons screening stations at each court facility in the County, with the exception of the Solvang court, which is only used on a part-time basis. Each entrance screening station will be equipped with a magnetometer, and x-ray package screening equipment. Each station will be staffed by a Sheriff's Deputy and two private security guards hired by the Court. It is anticipated that a total of eight (8) deputy sheriff positions will be needed to complete the Sheriff's staffing of the weapons screening plan for the Courts.

The implementation plan calls for a phased deployment of personnel and equipment, with the Lompoc Courthouse as the first courthouse to receive the weapons screening equipment. Lompoc Court was chosen to be first for implementation because it will involve minimal remodeling to create a secure entrance. The weapons screening at the Lompoc Courthouse is scheduled to go on line in September 2008. In addition, the Courts have asked for an immediate increase in security staffing at the Santa Barbara Courthouse. The remainder of the screening stations will go on line over the next eighteen months.

Narrative:

The average cost of a Deputy Sheriff in FY2008-09 is \$119,000. The Superior Court has received funding to offset the costs of these weapons screening personnel, so there will be no net cost to the County. Budget Revision Request 2007396 recognizes additional revenue from the Courts and appropriates the same amount in Salaries and Benefits to cover the cost of the three added positions for the remainder of FY2008-09.

The Courts are now initiating their weapons screening process in Santa Barbara County. The process involves staff and equipment hired by the Courts, overseen by a Sheriff's Department Bailiff. This increased level of service was not included in the FY2008-09 budget submittal as the details of service and cost had not been finalized. In a staged approach, the Lompoc Court will be the first venue to have this service, other locations will follow. This revision increases revenue from the Courts and increases Salary & Benefits for three Deputy Sheriff positions to be added to the department. The costs of the three deputies is 10/12th of the average cost (\$119,500) per the CSA 32 calculation. The entrance screening/increased security staffing has either already begun or will begin in September for all three positions.
