That the Board of Supervisors approves the attached proposed amendments to the Conflicts of Interest Code of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District ("District").

Summary Text:

The District's Conflicts of Interest Code amendments were adopted September 20, 2010. The amendments include a revision of titles of existing designated positions, deletes titles of positions that have been abolished and incorporates previously adopted amendment that was inadvertently deleted in prior Biennial review that authorized Control Officer to exercise discretion over disclosure requirements for consultants. (See attached "2010 Local Agency Biennial Notice")

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

- 1. Adopt local conflicts of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees;
- 2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflicts of interest codes on a biennial basis.

The revised Conflicts of Interest Code would be effective once approved by your Board.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Adopt amendments to the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District Conflict of Interest Code that reflect new job classifications created by the District.
- 2. Reinstate a prior amendment which was inadvertently omitted when the District's Conflict of Interest Code was last updated.

DISCUSSION:

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000 *et seq.* ("Act"), requires state and local agencies to adopt conflict of interest codes. (See Gov. Code Sections 87300 – 87301.) The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 18730, which contains the terms of standard conflict of interest and which may be incorporated by reference by local governmental agencies. Section 18730 is amended from time to time by the commission. The District last updated its Conflict of Interest Code in 2008.

Pursuant to the Act, the District is required to designate employees and consultants who are required to file annual statements of economic interest. The proposed amendments to the attached Conflict of Interest Code incorporate changes made to job classifications created by the District since the code was last amended in 2008.

When the District's Conflict of Interest Code was last amended in March of 2008, a previously adopted amendment to our Code was inadvertently omitted. In September of 2000, the District's Conflict of Interest Code was amended to authorize the Control Officer to exercise discretion regarding the applicability of disclosure requirements for consultants when consultants perform

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000 *et seq.*, requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a Regulation, 2 California.

Administrative Code section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings. The terms of 2 California Administrative Code section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and along with the attached Appendices "A" and "B" in which officials, consultants, and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District.

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Standard Code, designated officers, employees and consultants shall file statements of economic interest with the District. Upon receipt of the statements by the Control Officer, the District shall make and retain a copy and file the original with the Elections Division of the Santa Barbara County Clerk-Recorder's Office, 1100 Anacapa Street, Santa Barbara, California, or at such other location as is hereinafter designated by the Clerk-Recorder.

² Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation: The Control Officer may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position", is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultants duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Control Officer's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.

Pursuant to Title 2, Section 18730(b)(3), Governing Board members who are County Board of Supervisors do not need to file an expanded Conflict of Interest statement pursuant to this District Code.

CATEGORY 4

Business positions or investments in business entities and income from any source or sources of income, if:

- a) The business entities or the source or sources of income are of the type which, within the previous two years, have furnished or contracted to furnish, in the future with reasonable forseeability might furnish or contract to furnish services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment as a subcontractor in any contact with the District to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to or for the use of the District; and if
- b) Within the previous two years, the designated employee has made, participated in making, or in any way has attempted to use his or her official position to influence, the governmental decision to obtain or procure services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of the same or a similar type as those so provided or contracted to be provided to the District.
