Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and execute a Professional Services Contract with Lenvik & Minor Architects for architectural, engineering and construction administration services relating to the design and construction of the Isla Vista Foot Patrol offices. The Contract period shall extend from August 2, 2005 through December 30, 2006 in an amount not to exceed \$164,500.00, which includes reimbursable expenses.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2. A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On July 13, 2004 the Board authorized the Sheriff's Department to proceed with the planning of the new Isla Vista Foot Patrol offices and to negotiate with a qualified architectural firm to provide the necessary construction documents and construction administration for the project.

The Sheriff's Department has completed negotiations with the firm of Lenvik & Minor Architects, a local vendor. Lenvik & Minor were selected based on their experience, knowledge of law enforcement operations and their successful past performances with the County as well as their experience on a number of projects with the University of California Santa Barbara.

The original estimates for the A&E services were based on constructing a building on our own property and not on University property. With the addition of the University as a regulatory review agency, the work involved in the preparation of the construction documents increased considerably, thus the increase in the A&E fees from the original estimate.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change in programs or service levels

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Approximately 5,500 square feet will be added to the Sheriff's Department building totals.

The original estimates for the project are as follows:

Contingency	137,500.
1% for the Arts	13,750.
Pre-bid, Bid, Permits, Testing	50,000.
Architects fees	137,500.
Building Construction (includes contractor o&p)	1,375,000.

The COP (Long Term Bonds) balance is \$1,694,678.
