





That the Board of Directors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for the Maria Ygnacio Creek, Main Branch and East Branch Revegetation Project by Chambers Group, Inc. (not a local vendor), in the amount of \$292,019.44; and
- b) Find that pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15162, no new effects will occur and no new mitigation measures would be required as a result of the action and therefore pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Section 15168 (c)(2), that the action is within the scope of the project covered by the Updated Debris Basin Maintenance and Management Plan, approved in 2021 as a California Environmental Quality Act Addendum to the actions covered by the Program Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Routine Maintenance Program (01-EIR-01), as approved in 2001 (documents can be located here):

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to obtain Board approval and authorization to execute the Statement of Final Quantities (SFQ) for the Maria Ygnacio Creek, Main Branch and East Branch Revegetation Project

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(Project No. SC8349 & SC8351) located in the unincorporated area, in the South Coast, in the 2nd Supervisorial District.

On August 13, 2019, the Board entered into an agreement with Chambers Group, Inc. for the Maria Ygnacio Creek, Main Branch and East Branch Revegetation Project. This project restored the areas disturbed during the grading and construction activities of the Maria Ygnacio Creek, Main Branch and East Branch Debris Basin Modification Project.

The revegetation and restoration agreement was awarded in the amount of \$299,211.60 with an authorized contingency of \$27,460.52 for a total amount of \$326,672.18. The project was completed at a cost of \$292,019.44.

After the completion of the modification project in September 2019, the planting portion of the revegetation and restoration work started. The planting and plant establishment effort took three (3) years and was completed in April 2023.

The Flood Control District (District) has accepted the work of the contractor Chambers Group, Inc, completed per plans and specifications. On April 24, 2023, the Notice of Completion for this project was recorded by the Clerk Recorder's office.

Background:

The Maria Ygnacio Creek Main and the Maria Ygnacio Creek East Debris Basins are located along the main and east branches of Maria Ygnacio Creek, a tributary of Atascadero Creek and the Goleta Slough, approximately 5.7 miles and 5 miles from the Pacific Ocean, respectively. These facilities were funded by the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and constructed by the District as an emergency response to the Painted Cave Fire in 1990 to mitigate the effects of the post-fire debris flows.

The District's intent for this project was to restore natural vegetation and riparian corridor functions in the area.

Costs for the initial planting and revegetation work were included in FY 2019-20 budget in the South Coast Flood Zone in the Water Resources Division of the Public Works Department. Costs have continued to be included in the budget for the past three (3) fiscal years to allow establishment and provide maintenance of the revegetation sites. No General Fund monies were utilized for these projects.

These projects were also included in the Capital Improvement Program.
