Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve the appointment of Khalid Kaldi to the Goleta Valley Library Advisory Commission for a term expiring on June 30, 2026 to represent the unincorporated service area of Goleta Valley; and
- b) Determine that the recommendation of appointments to the Goleta Valley Library Advisory Commission is not the approval of a project that is subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), finding that the action involves government organizational or administrative activities which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

Summary Text:

The role of the Goleta Valley Library Advisory Commission is to advise the Goleta City Council and increase citizen participation in library issues by analyzing needs, considering goals, anticipating future needs and problems, acting as a liaison, acting as a sounding board, and to help develop consensus for advisement to the City Council.

Effective July 1, 2018, the Goleta Valley Library became a City Municipal Library. The Goleta Municipal Code provides that, "Three members of the Commission suggested by the County Board of Supervisors shall be appointed by the Mayor to represent the unincorporated service area of the Goleta

Valley.” (Goleta Municipal Code 2.14.040.) One of the three members of the Commission representing the unincorporated service area of the Goleta Valley must be a resident of the Isla Vista Community Services District. (Goleta Municipal Code 2.14.050.)

Background:

Library services in the County are provided via the Cities’ main libraries and various branch locations as a way to efficiently use existing facilities and prevent the creation of County-operated duplicate establishments. As of July 1, 2018, the City of Goleta took over management of the Goleta Library, becoming a Municipal Library.

The role of the Library Advisory Commission is to advise the City Council and increase citizen participation in library issues by analyzing needs, considering goals, anticipating future needs and problems, acting as a liaison, action as a sounding, and to help develop consensus for advisement to the City Council. The Commission shall be comprised of five members appointed by the Mayor. The Mayor will appoint three members suggested by the County Board of Supervisors to represent the unincorporated service are of the Goleta Valley. One of the three members must be a resident of the Isla Vista Community Service District. The remaining two members must be residents of the City of Goleta.
