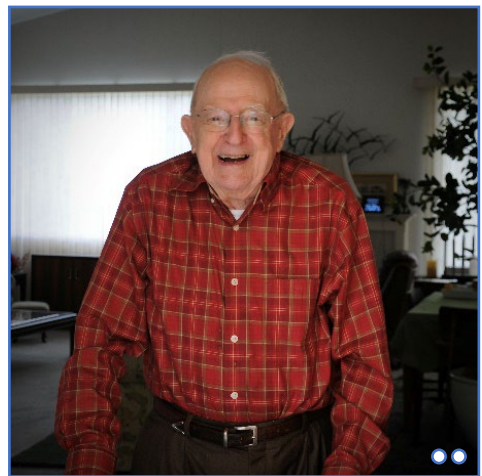


# American Rescue Plan Act Senior Meal Program COVID-Related Operating Grants Program



On July 18, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved agreements totaling \$218,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to support programs that enhance the nutrition of seniors by providing home-delivered meals to senior citizens, aged 60 years and older, in the County of Santa Barbara. Since that date, these programs have provided over 307,000 home-delivered meals to over 5,500 seniors. Each program’s individual accomplishments from July 2023 through March 2024 are shown in Table 1 below. Staff anticipates that all eight of the senior meal program providers will meet or exceed the goals established in their Agreements with the County of Santa Barbara.
