WHEREAS, Maryan has been a Santa Barbara County resident for over 30 years, during which time she has donated her time and expertise to a number of local nonprofits and community organizations including: Direct Relief, Santa Barbara City College, Domestic Violence Solutions, the Santa Barbara Foundation, United Way, Music Academy of the West, New Beginnings, Santa Barbara Museum of Art, Santa Barbara Natural History Museum, The Women's Fund, Cottage Hospital, Council of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse, Cancer Society of Santa Barbara, and the Courthouse Legacy Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Maryan and her husband Dick are trusted leaders in our community having been named Santa Barbara County Philanthropists of the Year in 2003; they received the Pierre Claeyssen's Award for Distinguished Service in 2007; and the Child Abuse Listening Mediation Claire Miles Award in 2010. In addition, Maryan was named Santa Barbara Foundation Woman of the Year in 2008 and Visiting Nurse and Hospice Mother of the Year in 2011; and
