That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to sign and submit on the Board's behalf, the FY 2008-09 JPCF Program Agreement with the Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) including any amendments or extensions thereof.

Summary Text:

The Probation Department is mandated to supervise cases referred by the Court. This funding allows us to enhance services provided to minors and their families. For statutory mandates governing the Probation Department please see Attachment A.

Background:

In FY 2005-06, Assembly Bill 139 (Chapter 74, Statutes of 2005) added Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 18220 through 18221 to provide Juvenile Probation Funding. This State funding replaced what in recent fiscal years was the Probation portion of a federal block grant program known as TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families). The funding is administered by the State of California CSA (formerly the Board of Corrections).

In compliance with this legislation, these monies provide for continued funding of juvenile probation services that promote increased self-sufficiency, personal responsibility, and family stability for at risk

youth and their families. Services are provided by Probation staff at the Juvenile Hall and at the Los Prietos Boys Camp and Academy programs. In addition, the Probation Department contracts with the Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services Department (ADMHS) to provide counseling services and treatment services at the Hall and Camp programs. For status offender youth in the community, the Probation Department contracts with community based organizations (CBOs) to provide emergency shelter care placement, counseling and family reunification services.
