- Events held on private property and require planning permits.
- Events that don't require planning permits and use public rights-of--ways or facilities.

CEO Policy Goals

- To improve efficiency through interdepartmental coordination & communication
- To improve accountability through identifying plans and potential factors for consideration
- To increase customer focus by working together for successful events

Policy Expectations

- No new requirements
- Community Services Director to be lead
- Discussions inclusive of responsible departments
- Potential factors for consideration
- Ongoing review of policy effectiveness

Recommended Actions

- Receive information about County Executive Office's (CEO) new policy on improving the internal process for coordinating Special Event Permit requests; and
- Determine that, via California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections
 15378(b) (4) and 15352, the actions are not the approval of a project subject to the CEQA
