RESOLUTION HONORING

UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM

WHEREAS, prior to civil service with the State of California, Ct. Moncher served six years of active duty with the U.S. Air Force achieving the rank of Sr. MSgt. And during his tenure with the CHP served fourteen years with the U.S. Air Force Reserves; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Moncher was decorated with the Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), and the Kuwait Liberation Medal (Emirate of Kuwait), Armed Forces Service and Reserve Medals, Air Force Overseas Short Tour Medal and numerous other Awards and Ribbons; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 1981, Lt. Moncher joined the CHP and served in Glendale, Marin and Santa Rosa areas, and Golden Gate Division office before promoting to the rank of Sergeant, on December 2, 1992; he then served in the Hayward area, Golden Gate Division, and the Information Management Division office before promoting to the rank of Lieutenant on March 1, 1997; and there he served in the West Valley area, Southern Division office, Conejo Inspection Facility, Buellton and Santa Maria areas as Area Commander; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Moncher is the proud husband to Andi, and the proud father of four, Brian Jeremy, Nichole and Shannon; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2005, CHP Lt. Bruce D. Moncher, Area Commander for the Santa Maria vicinity will retire after 24 years and 8 months of service with the Department; and of recognition thereof, he is deserving of special honors and the highest commendations.
