**SUBJECT:** Initiation of the Annexation of Jensen's Crossing/Cobblestone Creek Tract 14,429 into

North County Lighting Districts and County Service Area # 5 (Orcutt) - Fourth

Supervisorial District

### **Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

A. Adopt the attached resolution initiating proceedings to annex territory to the North County Lighting District and County Service Area #5 (Orcutt), specifically Jensen's Crossing/Cobblestone Creek Tract 14,429 APN 103-200-068 and 103-200-069.

### **Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2: A safe and healthy community in which to live work and visit.

## **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

This proceeding is taken pursuant to the Cortese/Knox/Hertzbert Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, commencing with Section 56000 of the California Government Code.

The reasons for the proposal are to provide street lighting to a proposed residential subdivision of 115 homes and to include the property within County Service Area No. 5 (Orcutt) which funds parks and open space maintenance for the community.

#### **Mandates and Service Levels:**

The Planning Commission approved Jensen's Crossing/Cobblestone Creek Tract 14,429 on March 1, 2000, conditioned upon annexation of the property to the North County Lighting District. As a result, streetlights will be provided to this development at service levels similar to other properties in the Orcutt area.

Concurrent annexation of the territory to County Service Area No. 5 (Orcutt) will ensure that this property contribute to the maintenance of community parks and open space similar to other properties in Orcutt.

### **Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

This change will increase the number of streetlights by 31 and add a total of \$1693.95 per fiscal year in benefit assessments for lighting. The \$2,125.00 LAFCO processing fee, \$100.00 LAFCO supplemental fee, plus a \$1,100.00 deposit for the County Surveyor office to review the map and legal description for the annexation, are being paid by the developer.
