SUBJECT: Co-sponsorship of the 2003 Toys for Tots & Food Drive Campaigns

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider co-sponsoring the 2003 Toys for Tots Campaign and the Christmas Unity food drive for Santa Barbara County Employees.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The annual Toys for Tots Campaign is sponsored by Volt Temporary Services in conjunction with the United States Marine Corps Reserve. The food drive is sponsored directly by the Council of Christmas Cheer. Toys and food will be collected at several drop off locations within the County offices and distributed to disadvantaged children in our community through the Council of Christmas Unity Shop. Your Board's co-sponsorship would serve to authorize County staff to coordinate employee participation by establishing donation boxes, etc.

The holidays are a time for sharing with those in our community who are less fortunate and need a little extra help. The Toys for Tots and food drive campaigns provide an opportunity for the County family to participate as an organization and contribute to our community. The Board has previously been a co-sponsor of the Toy for Tots and food drive for many years. Several County Divisions have participated in the food drive in a minor capacity and will continue to do so.
