**SUBJECT:** Application for 2006 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Funds

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## **Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Authorize the County Administrator to sign the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Santa Barbara and the County of Santa Barbara for the 2006 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program (Attachment A).
- B. Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to apply for and accept the 2006 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).

## **Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2: Ensure the Public Health and Safety and Provide Essential Infrastructure, and Goal No. 5: Maintain and Enhance the Quality of Life for all Residents.

## **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

Santa Barbara County has received Byrne Formula Grant funding for 15 years and Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) funding for nine years. In an effort to streamline justice funding and grant administration, the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs created the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). The 2006 JAG funds will be used to support the Santa Barbara Regional Narcotics Enforcement Team (SBRNET) which was previously funded by the Byrne Formula Grant.

As stated in previous Board Letters, this project is a collaborative effort between all local law enforcement agencies to apply certain strategies designed to reduce the flow of narcotics through

our county. The project uses searches, buy-bust operations, and street sweeps to accomplish the desired reduction of narcotics. It targets both street level dealers and major vendors operating within Santa Barbara County.

JAG funding will be used to offset the costs of one Deputy District Attorney IV, one Deputy Probation Officer, Senior and one full-time Office Assistant Senior to be assigned to SBRNET, as well as to offset the costs associated with having a Peace Officer assigned to SBRNET by the Santa Barbara Police Department and the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department. There will be an additional allocation of funds from the California State Office of Emergency Services (OES) that will further offset these costs. We will return to your Board when the amount of that award and application is made available to Probation.

**Mandates and Service Levels:**

This is not a mandated program, although many of the services provided are mandated by statutes and court orders. Statutory mandates governing Probation Department services are attached for your review (Attachment B).

**Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

JAG provides \$16,644 to Santa Barbara County and \$35,738 to Santa Barbara City for a total FY 2006-07 award of \$52,382. JAG requires that the County be the applicant and be responsible for administration of the joint funds. JAG has no match requirement and does not cause the General Fund contribution to increase.

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA, CA  
AND COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, CA**

**2006 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD**

This Agreement is made and entered into this first day of March, 2006, by and between The COUNTY of Santa Barbara, acting by and through its County Administrator, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY of Santa Barbara, acting by and through its City Administrator, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Santa Barbara County, State of California, witnesseth:

**WHEREAS**, this agreement is made in anticipation of an award of funds under the JAG Program for the Santa Barbara Regional Narcotic Enforcement Team (SBRNET) Program, and IF such grant is awarded: and,

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY and the CITY, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and,

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY and the CITY finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this Agreement: and,

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY agrees to provide the CITY \$11,786 from the JAG award for the Santa Barbara Regional Narcotic Enforcement Team (SBRNET) Program: and,

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds: and,

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY serve as the applicant and will be responsible for the administration of the joint funds; monitoring the award; submitting reports including performance measure and program assessment data; and providing ongoing assistance to any sub recipients of the funds.

**NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:**

**Section 1.**

COUNTY agrees to pay CITY a total of \$11,786 of JAG funds.

**Section 2.**

COUNTY agrees to use \$40,596 for the SBRNET Program for FY 2006-07.

**Section 3.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the California Tort Claims Act.

**Section 4.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the California Tort Claims Act.

**Section 5.**

Each party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

**Section 6.**

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

**Section 7.**

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.
