Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Directors:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Subdivider's Agreement to construct and maintain private drainage improvements with Harris Grade Limited Partnership, owners of Bluffs at Mesa Oaks Phases II and III, Tract 14,499 (APNs: 097-250-47, 097-250-48, and 097-250-66).

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The Subdivider's Agreement is a condition of approval for Bluffs at Mesa Oaks, Phases II and III subdivision, located east of Harris Grade Road, just north of Highway 1 and Purisma Road, in the Lompoc area. This agreement will require the present and future owners of the property to be responsible for the maintenance in perpetuity of the private drainage improvements of Tract 14.499.

Mandates and Service Levels:

These private drainage improvements will address the increase in runoff associated with the development of Tract 14,499. These improvements will provide adequate drainage infrastructure that will benefit the development.
