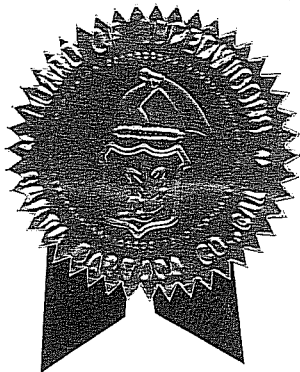
WHEREAS, Mark Mooney, throughout his career, provided the employees of the Sheriff's Department positive leadership and professionalism; and
