That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider, accept and forward to the Office of the Governor, Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisor nomination(s) of at least one member of a Board of Supervisors and/or at least one member of a City Council from San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties for appointment as the South Central Coast Region representative on the California Coastal Commission.

Summary Text:

The County of Santa Barbara has received a letter (attached) from the Appointments Secretary of the Office of Governor Schwarzenegger requesting nomination(s) by the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors for a position on the California Coastal Commission representing the South Central Coast Region.

The South Central Coast region consists of Santa Barbara, Ventura and San Luis Obispo Counties. The vacancy that exists must be filled by a member of a City Council, or a member of a County Board of Supervisors from within the three Counties.

Included in the board letter packet is all biographical data received to date by individuals seeking a nomination by the Board of Supervisors. Any additional information received by prospective nominees will be forwarded to the Board as appropriate.

In addition to nomination(s) by the County Board of Supervisors, elected representatives of the eight incorporated cities within Santa Barbara County will also have an opportunity to nominate individuals at a meeting of the Santa Barbara County City Selection Committee that is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, November 4, 2010. Staff will inform the Board of the actions of the City Selection Committee subsequent to that meeting.

A copy of Public Resources Code Section 30300 et seq., which sets forth this procedure, is attached for your Board's information. The Appointments Secretary for Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger has requested that the list of nominees be submitted to the Office of the Governor no later than November 19, 2010.

Background:

The California Coastal Commission was established by voter initiative in 1972 and was made permanent by the Legislature through the adoption of the California Coastal Act of 1976.

The Commission, in partnership with coastal cities and counties, plans and regulates the use of land and water in the coastal zone. Development activities, which are broadly defined by the Coastal Act to include (among others) construction of buildings, divisions of land, and activities that change the intensity of use of land or public access to coastal waters, generally require a coastal permit from either the Coastal Commission or the local government.

The Commission is composed of twelve voting members, appointed equally (four each) by the Governor, the Senate Rules Committee, and the Speaker of the Assembly. Six of the voting commissioners are locally elected officials and six are appointed from the public at large. Three ex officio (non-voting) members represent the Resources Agency, the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, and the State Lands Commission.

The elected official position for the South Central Coast Region is currently represented by San Luis Obispo County Supervisor Katcho Achadjian who is a candidate for the 33rd State Assembly District.
