SUBJECT: Donation of Sheriff Council Funds to Sheriff's Department

That the Board of Supervisors;

- Accept a donation of \$157,715.67 from the Sheriff's Council for use by the Sheriff's 1) Department, and
- Approve Budget Revision #2006166 recognizing the donation revenue and appropriating 2) expenditures for various equipment purchases.

Summary:

The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council has presented to the Sheriff's Department checks totaling \$157,715.67. The Sheriff has determined that funds will go towards the purchase of the following:

Handicapped-Accessible van	\$	40,000.00
Radios for Search & Rescue team	\$	25,935.00
Tasers for Custody Staff	\$	43,810.00
Tasers for Patrol Staff	\$	15,000.00
Bullet & Spike vests for sworn staff	\$	16,970.67
Implementation of Project Lifesaver	\$	16,000.00
Total	\$1	157.715.67

The handicapped-accessible van will be purchased as an assigned vehicle and replaces an old operating cost van that has reached the end of its useful life. This vehicle does not increase the size of the fleet.

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The radios for the Search & Rescue team replace equipment that is several years old and worn from use. Radio communication among team members is critical during rescue operations. This equipment will provide new units for all team members.

The purchase of 41 taser units for use by Custody staff completes the Taser purchase program initiated by the Sheriff's Council last year. The proposed amount also includes sufficient cartridges to allow for training and field deployment.

The purchase of additional tasers for Patrol staff continues the Taser program initiated by the Sheriff's Council for new members of the department. As the department fills vacant positions, additional tasers are required for issuance to these deputies. This allocation of the donation will cover the cost of approximately 17 additional Tasers.

The purchase of additional bullet and spike vests continues a program initiated by the Sheriff's Council several years ago. The department has relied on the Council to fund the purchase of vests for new employees. As the department fills its vacancies in the Custody Deputy and Deputy Sheriff categories, new vests fitted to the new staffed are ordered. This allocation of the donation will cover the cost of approximately 22 new vests.

Project Lifesaver is a program that equips law enforcement agencies with technology to track missing or disoriented adults or children equipped with a personalized wristband that emits a tracking signal. This allocation pays for three tracking units for use by the department. Wristbands are purchased by individuals or private care facilities. Training is being arranged with San Luis Obispo County, who already has a program like this in place.

Background:

This recommendation is aligned with Goal #2, A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

The Sheriff's Council is a California Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation organized for charitiable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purpose of the Sheriff's Council is to raise funds for the purchase of material and equipment for use by the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department.

Donation of Sheriff Council Funds to Sheriff's Department

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Narrative:

Budget revision #2006166 recognizes the donation revenue and allocates \$101,715.67 to the Services and Supplies object level for the purchase of the tasers, vests and radios. \$40,000 is allocated to the Vehicle Operations line item in the Other Charges object level to pay for the handicapped van. The ongoing annual cost of operating the van including depreciation, maintenance and gas will be approximately \$15,000 per year and will be included into the FY2007-08 budget. Current year expense will be nominal as the delivery date for the vehicle is several months out. \$16,000 is allocated to the Fixed Asset line item to pay for the Project Lifesaver equipment.

The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council has donated \$157,715.67 in cash to the Sheriff's Department. The deposit was made with the Treasurers Office on September 13, 2006. This revision recognizes the donation revenue and appropriates expenditures to fund several projects. \$40,000 will be used to purchase a new handicapped - accessible van for use by the Jail (LI 7893). \$25,935 will be used to replace the radios used by the Search and Rescue Team (LI 7050). \$43,810 will be used to purchase tasers for Custody staff (LI 7650). \$31,970 will be used to purchase additional tasers for patrol staff and bullet-proof vests for new employees (LI 7030 and 7650). \$16,000 will be used to purchase tracking equipment for use with Project Lifesaver (LI 8300).
