That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an agreement with the Santa Ynez Tribal Business Council to provide animal control services for the period of January 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 in the amount of \$2,410.

Summary Text:

This is a request to execute an agreement with the Santa Ynez Business Council to provide full animal control services. This is an updated agreement utilizing a per capita methodology structure for fees.

Services will be provided from the community animal shelter located in Lompoc. Animal control services include patrolling, impounding, boarding, redemption, adoption or euthanization and a variety of investigations. Under the agreement, the County functions as the agent of the Tribal Council for all animal related matters and enforces Ordinance No. 8: Tribal Ordinance Regulating the Control of Domestic Animals. The services also include the rabies control program, bite investigations and quarantine services.

Background: The County previously contracted with the Santa Ynez Tribal Business Council on a fee for service basis. The services provided are the same as under the previous agreement. The change in this agreement is in the fee methodology in order to become consistent with the other full service agreements currently in place with other jurisdictions for animal control services.

Narrative:

Executing this Agreement will not increase the department's request for General Fund Contribution or use of A87 Plan Overhead. A per capita rate of \$5.56 is used to calculate the contract. The Santa Ynez Tribal population is 289. The annual amount is contracted at \$1,607 (\$5.56 x 289). This Agreement is for eighteen months and therefore the amount is \$2,410, to be invoiced quarterly.

These contract revenues are included in the FY 2006-2007 Public Health Department Adopted Budget in the Animal Services Cost Center found on page D-188 in the County's Operating Plan document and in the FY 2007-2008 Recommended Budget.
