RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing a (3-way) Stop Control on North Jameson at Hixon Road in the Montecito Area.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

The intersection of North Jameson Lane and Hixon Road is a 3-way intersection. This location has had temporary stop signs during the construction on North Jameson Lane. Numerous residents in the area requested that the stops be made permanent. An investigation was performed at this intersection to determine whether stop signs were warranted. The results of this investigation showed that stop signs are warranted at this intersection due to limited sight distance on the north side of North Jameson Lane. Based on our investigation, it was determined that a 3-way stop on North Jameson Lane at Hixon Road would be appropriate. The Public Works Department Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a 3-way stop control at the following location:

- On North Jameson Lane at its intersection with Hixon Road.
