WHEREAS, Title 14, Section 852 of the Code of California Regulations promulgated development of an Santa Barbara County Oil Spill Contingency Plan for coastal jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County is a coastal jurisdiction with substantial oil and gas activity within the state of California;

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Office of Emergency Management serves as the lead department for the Operational Area in emergency planning and management;

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Office of Emergency Management, as part of a memorandum of understanding with the State of California, serves as the local agency representative on an offshore Incident Command Team (“Unified Command”);

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management maintains the Oil Spill Contingency Plan for the Santa Barbara County Operational Area;

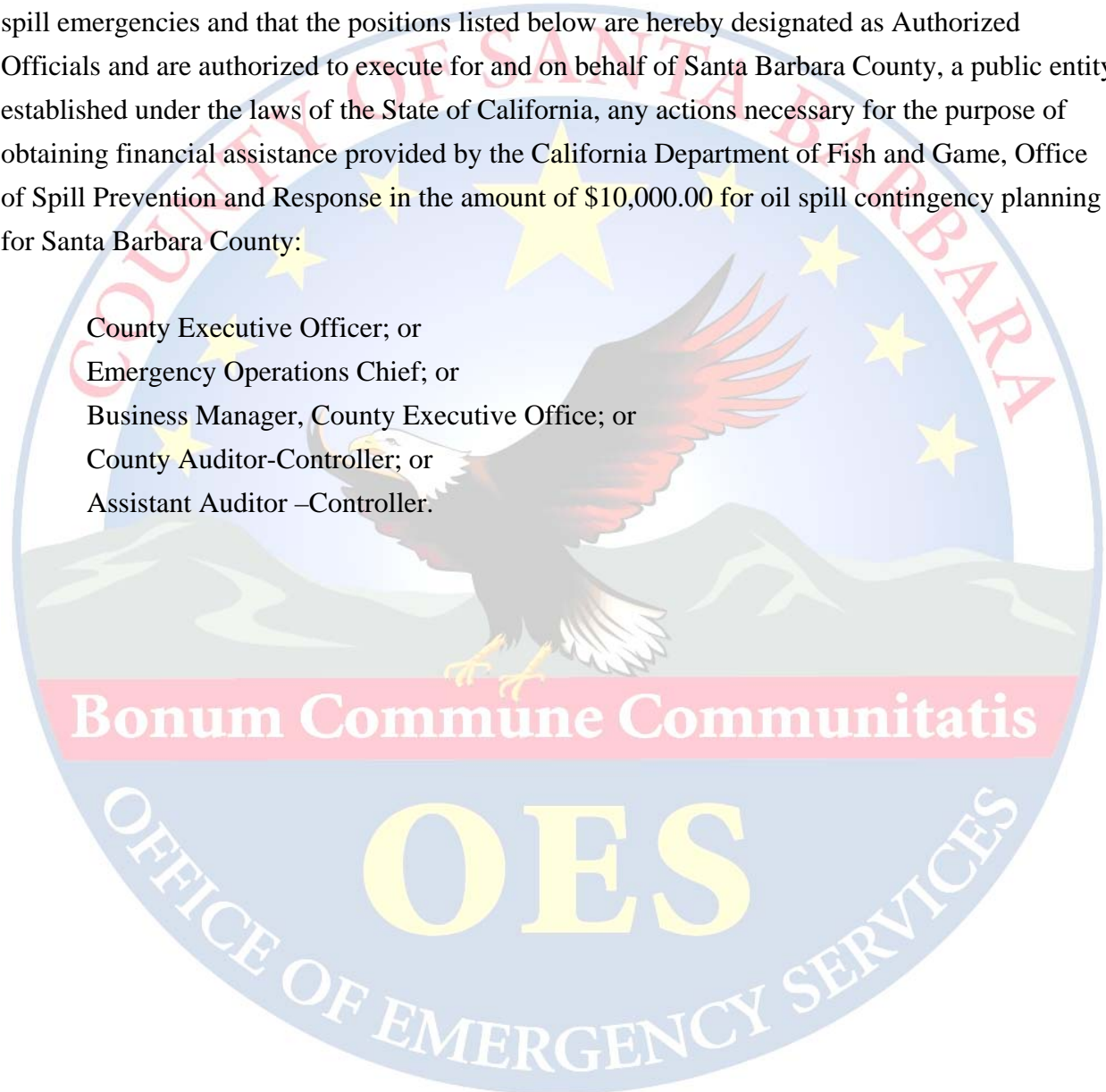
WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County has fulfilled its requirements under the grant program and has received California Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response approval for the Santa Barbara County Oil Spill Contingency Plan;

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Offices of Emergency Management, applied to the California Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response for grant funding to participate in the Area Contingency Planning Program for the Santa Barbara County Operational Area; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response has approved Santa Barbara County Offices of Emergency Management to receive \$10,000 in area contingency planning grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County hereby approves the Santa Barbara County Oil Spill Contingency Plan for marine oil spill emergencies and that the positions listed below are hereby designated as Authorized Officials and are authorized to execute for and on behalf of Santa Barbara County, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by the California Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response in the amount of \$10,000.00 for oil spill contingency planning for Santa Barbara County:

Emergency Operations Chief; or
Business Manager, County Executive Office; or
County Auditor-Controller; or
Assistant Auditor –Controller.
