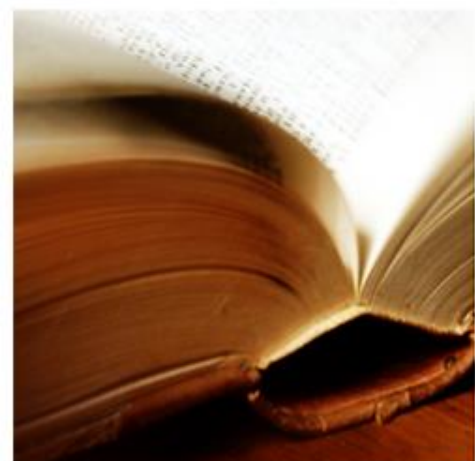


Senate Bill 32

Global Warming: emissions limit

May 19, 2015



SB 32 Summary

- Currently, statewide GHG emissions are to be limited to 1990 levels by 2020
- SB 32, requires that GHG emissions be limited to 80% of 1990 levels by 2050
- Authorizes ARB to approve 2030 and 2040 interim GHG emission targets, consistent with the 2050 limit.
- In achieving the 2050 GHG emissions limit, adopted policies should ensure long-term emission reductions advance all of the following:
 - Job growth and local economic benefits in the state.
 - Public health benefits for Californians, particularly in disadvantaged communities.
 - Innovation in technology and energy and resource management practices.
 - Regional and international collaboration to adopt similar GHG emission reduction policies.

Recommended Actions

Option 1:

- A. Take an advocacy position of support, watch, or oppose on SB 32 (Pavley): California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006: emissions limit; and
- B. Direct staff to forward, and authorize the Chair to sign a letter stating the Board's decision to the legislative author, members of the legislature including, but not limited to, the county legislative delegation, and appropriate committee chairs; and

Option 2:

- A. Take no position on SB 32 (Pavley): California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006: emissions limit
