
Whereas, *Being a Boy Scout of America means you are a member of a worldwide youth movement that stands for certain values and beliefs; and*

Whereas, *the County of Santa Barbara celebrates the recognition of St. John Neumann Catholic Church for their contribution and exemplary service through Scouting.*




