Executive Summary and Discussion:

The project consisted of removing and repairing failed areas in the existing pavement, cold planing, pavement reinforcing fabic and placement of a Type B asphalt concrete overlay over an asphalt concrete leveling course. Approximately 31 lane miles of County maintained roadway was resurfaced with the construction of this project.

The contract was accepted on October 24, 2002, and was completed on time and within the allotted contract amount.
