**Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors conduct a Gaviota Preservation Workshop on Monday August 18, 2008, at 9:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room in Santa Barbara.

**Summary Text:**

As you may recall during a recent Board meeting, there was some discussion about holding a Board Workshop to discuss the current status and prospects for preservation of the Gaviota Coast. Such a workshop could take place at a regular Board meeting, or it could be scheduled as a special Monday meeting so that there would not be the pressure of other matters requiring decisions which can limit the amount of time available for more general workshops of this nature.

The meeting could address the following:

- A map presentation of the current land uses and ownership status on the Gaviota Coast.
- A GIS presentation of uses and assessed values of privately owned parcels.
- An outline of proposed/pending development projects.
- The geographic history of the preservation efforts which have been achieved to date.
- A presentation of known future preservation efforts and their current status.
- Brief presentations by groups which have preservation efforts underway or planned.
- Public comment.

- Board discussion and possible direction.

Since this could be a well attended meeting, it could be held on a Monday morning at 9:00 a.m. in Santa Barbara. In order to give people time to prepare, I suggest it be held on Monday August 18th.
