

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE JUVENILE)
JUSTICE DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND ACCEPTANCE) RESOLUTION NO. _____
OF THE YOUTHFUL OFFENDER BLOCK GRANT)**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 81 and clean up legislation under Assembly Bill 191 resulted in significant policy changes regarding commitments to the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) commencing September 1, 2007. The new legislation now prohibits the further incarceration of wards adjudicated for non-707(b) Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) offenses (excluding certain sex offenses) at DJJ facilities; allows for the committing court to recall some, all, or none of the commitment orders for non-707(b) WIC offenders currently committed to DJJ; requires that all non-707(b) WIC offenders in DJJ facilities who are released to parole will be returned to the county of commitment for community supervision; and requires that all current non-707(b) WIC offenders whose parole is suspended, cancelled or revoked, will be returned to the custody of the county of commitment; and

WHEREAS, Section 1961 WIC required the Probation Department, by January 1, 2008, to prepare and submit to the Corrections Standard Authority (CSA) a Juvenile Justice Development Plan (JJDP) for youthful offenders which would include a description of the programs, placements, services, or strategies to be funded by the Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) allocation, a description of any regional agreements to be supported by the YOBG allocation, and a description of how these new programs coordinate with programs under Assembly Bill 1913; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department submitted the YOBG funding application, JJDP to CSA on December 28, 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara hereby authorizes the Chief Probation Officer to submit and/or sign the County's YOBG application and related contracts, amendments, or extensions with the State of California, that forms the County's JJDP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara assures that the County of Santa Barbara's JJDP has been developed, reviewed, and provided to the Corrections Standards Authority in a format determined by the Corrections Standards Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara assures that the County of Santa Barbara will adhere to the requirements of Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 1950 through 1962 regarding the use of YOBG funds and the specified uses detailed with the submission of the County's JJDP.
