That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Purchasing Manager to issue a purchase order for Biscom, Inc. for 2 FAXCOM fax servers in the amount of \$38,224.53 without a competitive bid. Biscom, Inc. is not a local vendor however is the only authorized seller of this product.

Summary:

The Biscom Fax Servers are being purchased to replace currently owned fax hardware that the department has had in place for over 5 years. Our current hardware is aged, undersized and will no longer be supported by the company's future product development. These fax servers are the key core technology behind the department's Broadcast Alert System. Public Health's Broadcast Alert System is a mission critical application allowing for the dissemination of press releases and health advisories to the community and functions as a key resource to the County in time of emergency. This system is also imperative to the collection of Confidential Morbidity Reports from providers throughout the County.

There are very few products that met the Department's needs; the Biscom software component is functionally superior to any other product that was researched. Purchasing the complete hardware and software package from this vendor will provide a single warranty for hardware, software and configuration issues. This will eliminate the potential troubleshooting and maintenance conflicts that can arise from using multiple vendors for hardware and software.
