That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the attached grant application narrative, (Attachment A), and adopt the attached resolution (Attachment B) approving up to a \$35,000 Economic Development Allocation CDBG grant application to the State Department of Housing and Community Development.
- 2. Authorize the Interim Housing and Community Development Director to submit the \$35,000 grant application to the California State Department of Housing and Community Development for funds to conduct traffic impact analysis and cost estimates for road improvements for a proposed visitor's center near Vandenberg Air Force Base.
- 3. Authorize the Housing and Community Development Interim Director to sign all documents required for grant administration and submittal of the CDBG application, grant agreement, drawdown of funds, and minor amendment requests.

Summary:

Application and Use of Funds

The CDBG grant application requests funds to conduct traffic impact analysis and estimate necessary road improvements for a proposed visitor's center located adjacent to Vandenberg Air Force Base 2006 Community Development Block Grant Application Planning and Technical Assistance Program 11/14/2006

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(VAFB). The County is applying for these funds on behalf of the Santa Maria-based California Space Authority (CSA), a nonprofit corporation representing the commercial, civil, and national defense/homeland security interests of California's space industry sector.

The proposed California Space Center (CSC) would be a new, multi-purpose project, supported by a collaborative of private and public partners. The CSC will significantly increase public awareness of space missions at Vandenberg, and will provide educational outreach to encourage children to study math, engineering, and science. The CSC will consist of facilities incorporate five elements: 1) Space-related visitor attractions; 2) Launch viewing area; 3) Space education multi-purpose area; 4) conference center; and 5) Mission support complex. The CSA is pursuing a long-term lease of 66-acres from VAFB, and is seeking additional investment capital for the project. Delaware North Companies Parks & Resorts has expressed interest in managing the facilities upon completion of development.

Background:

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The County has the opportunity to apply for State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for Economic Development. A grant application for such funds has been prepared and is described below.

The County is the eligible applicant for the CDBG funds, and is one of approximately 180 local governments throughout California that are in the State Small Cities CDBG Program. The federal source of the funds is the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

CDBG requires opportunities for Citizen Participation regarding the County's proposed use of CDBG funds. As part of the County's Citizen Participation Plan, the County sponsored a public hearing on October 16th, during which the State CDBG program and the County activity selection criteria were discussed for a 2006 application.

This hearing before the Board of Supervisors represents the second required public hearing on the 2006 CDBG application. Following the close of the Public Hearing, the Board is requested to take the actions listed above.

The required purpose of all CDBG funds is to benefit low and moderate income persons.

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Narrative:

If the grant is awarded, the County will receive \$35,000 of CDBG funds for the funding of a traffic analysis and road improvement cost estimates for the proposed California Space Center. In addition to the grant funds, \$1,750 will be provided by the County as matching funds for this grant in the form of staff time dedicated to activity delivery. If the County receives these grant funds, a budget revision will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors, to be added to the Department of Housing and Community Development budget.
