#### **Recommended Actions:**

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Receive the Planning Commission's findings regarding the conformity to the General Plan of projects recommended for planning, initiation or construction during Fiscal Years 2014-2019 under Government Code, Sections 65401 and 65402.
- b) Accept Notice of Statutory Exemption for FY 2014-19 Five Year Capital Improvement Program.

## **Summary Text:**

On May 20, 2014 the Board referred the list of new projects contained in the Five Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to the Planning Commission for the required G.C. 65401 and G.C. 65402 General Plan conformity report. The Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to review the list of new projects for preliminary conformity with the General Plan. The Planning Commission, by a vote of 5-0, found that all the 24 new projects (Attachment B) recommended for planning, initiation, or construction during FY 2014-2019 are consistent with the Santa Barbara County General Plan, pursuant to G.C. 65401 and all but seven projects (Attachments C & D) were consistent pursuant to G.C. 65402. The seven projects listed on Attachment D of the Staff Report for Planning Commission Hearing Five

Year Capital Improvement Program, May 28, 2014 require additional review under G.C. 65402 as the projects as more information is needed to complete the consistency review.

Prepared and administered by the County Executive Office, the Five Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is a key element toward greater long range financial and infrastructure planning. The CIP consists of both unfunded and funded projects that County departments are proposing to implement within the ensuing five-year period. Projects included in the CIP are non-recurring, have a long service life, are generally over \$100,000 and will be underway (if funded) at some point during fiscal years 2014-2019. While the CIP covers a five year planning period, it is updated each year to reflect ongoing changes; new projects are added, existing projects are modified and completed projects are deleted.
