That the Board of Supervisors:

Adopt a Resolution to authorize the County Treasurer to make temporary transfers between July 1, 2002 and April 28, 2003 from available funds to County Operating Funds, Special District Funds, and School District Funds in such amounts as may be directed by the County Auditor-Controller.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The 2002-03 secured taxes accruing will not be available to these agencies until tax collection time on or before December 31, 2002 and April 28, 2003. As a result, cash in these funds may be insufficient to meet obligations which will occur between July 1, 2002 and April 28, 2003.

Therefore, it is requested that the County Treasurer be authorized to make temporary transfers of not more than 85% of the revenues accruing to a fund, and all such temporary transfers be repaid to the County Treasurer from such taxes before any other obligations of said funds.
