Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors:

I am requesting the Board to require a CUP (Conditional Use Permit) for all new applications. If BOS will not change the proposed amendments to require a CUP for processing applicants who already have a Land Use Permit, I further request a requirement by the BOS to process indoors and use best available odor control technology.

Further, we need to put a brake on adding more odor, whatever the source. For the Santa Ynez Valley, the above solution will prevent adding more cannabis odor in Buellton and the area west and south of it. That odor already negatively impacts existing agriculture, the health of residents with sensitive receptors, its schools' children and tourism.

My wife and I are longtime residents of the Valley and feel that the cannabis is both extremely offensive and potentially harmful to our health and those of the other Valley residents.

This is a very important issue and we would like the BOS to take strong affirmative action. Thank you.
