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### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

When it rains, green waste chippings and garbage finds its way into the storm drains in violation of the operating Permit. To eliminate this problem the Solid Waste Division, with the assistance of the Water Agency and consultants, has designed an appropriate water clarifier system.

On May 27, 2004, eight (8) bids were opened for the South Coast Recycling & Transfer Station Storm Water Clarifier and Drainage Improvements. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Tierra Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$97,830.00, which is 18.35% below engineer's estimate. The Department has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid is responsible and reasonable.

Funding for this project is budgeted in Fund 1930, Program 1750, Department 054 and Account 8200 in the 04/05 budget year.
