COVID-19 Vaccine Planning

Initial Information - COVID-19 Vaccine Overview

- Pfizer and Moderna expected to receive FDA EUA approval
- Prioritization due to limited vaccine (allocation unknown)
 - **Phase 1a**
 - Health care workers
 - First responders
 - **Phase 1b**
 - Individuals at highest risk for developing severe illness
 - Older adults living in congregate or overcrowded settings
- Final CDPH prioritization pending

Additional details to be provided once further information from state and CDC is received



State of California COVID-19 Vaccine Plan

State's Objectives:

- Assure safe and prioritized distribution of vaccine to those most at risk
- Ensure equitable distribution and administration of vaccine
- Scientific Safety Review Workgroup tasked to review COVID-19 vaccine trial data and FDA and ACIP decisions

COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution

- Pharmacy Partnership for Long-term Care (LTC) Program
 - LTC facilities can sign up for CVS/Walgreen's on-site Phase 1B vaccination of residents and any staff not vaccinated in Phase 1A
 - Free of charge to LTC facilities



Santa Barbara County COVID-19 Vaccine Planning

- Purpose is to implement a phased approach based on vaccine availability.
- Modeled after the Centers for Disease Control's COVID Vaccination Playbook and CDPH recommendations.
- Formed COVID-19 Vaccination Workgroup with healthcare providers to receive and administer vaccine.







- Confirm support from cities to set up and manage POD sites and public information





Santa Barbara County COVID-19 By The Numbers


Cumulative Cases




7-Day Rolling Sum of New Cases by Area

Not including Lompoc Federal Correctional Complex





Daily Hospitalized Cases* by Date Reported to Public Health





Santa Barbara County 7-day Average Adjusted* Case Rate per 100,000 Community Residents




