WHEREAS, men and women alike must recognize the scope of this problem and work together to create a community which does not tolerate domestic violence; and

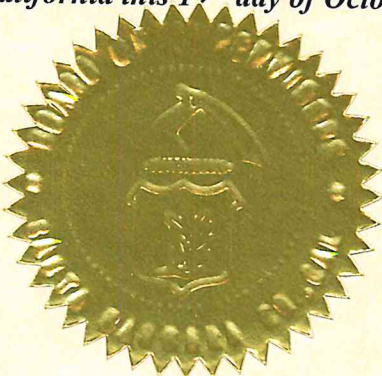
