Authorize the Fire Department to accept the Canine Search & Rescue Vehicle valued at \$34,086 as a gift from the Santa Barbara Firefighters Alliance.

Summary Text:

The SBFA has presented to the Fire Department a Canine Search & Rescue Vehicle. This vehicle will give the Fire Department the ability to carry on its Search & Rescue Canine Program and to fulfill the agreement that it has made with the Search Dog Foundation regarding transportation of the search dog. The search dog Handler and the search dog are an integral part of the Search & Rescue Program and provide service to the residents of the entire Santa Barbara County. In addition, the Handler and the dog, will have the potential to be called upon both nationally and internationally as part of a Regional Urban Search & Rescue Task Force.
