Name of Proposal being submitted: "Communities of Interest" of Santa Barbara County 2011 Redistricting Plan

Briefly describe your plan:
This proposed districting plan entails a redistricting of all five districts in Santa Barbara County to ensure not just equal population but enforce the communities of interest by re-orienting the districts to population centers found within the county's borders. This plan reallocates District 1 to capture Carpinteria to west downtown Santa Barbara, up to SBCC. District 2 would re-orient from downtown Santa Barbara to Isla Vista/Goleta. District 3 would then begin on the outskirts of Goleta, go north and west including the SB foothills and community on the southern end of Hwy 154 to the outskirts of Lompoc and into the southern end of Santa Maria. The 4th District would then encapsulate the coastal area of Lompoc, the city itself, the Air Force Base and north to Guadalupe, and include the western side of Santa Maria. District 5 would remain centered along the Santa Maria Valley and terminate on the western end in the downtown Santa Maria area.

Briefly describe the goals of your plan: (example: keep rural areas together, keep a city in a specific district, etc.)
The driving factor of this redistricting plan is primarily to preserve the communities of interest, moving the district boundaries to ensure equal population areas. For example District 1 and 2 become more centered on the Greater Santa Barbara area, and District 2 itself shares two colleges (SBCC & UCSB) - further enhancing the communities of interest. The separation of UCSB and Isla Vista from District 3 will result in more cohesiveness of both the county and its communities - potentially eliminating future voter legal action and even recall motions that have plagued previous 3rd district supervisors, and allow District 3 to be about the Santa Ynez Valley community. The 4th District becomes heavily centered on Lompoc, the Air Force base, and surrounding coastal communities. Lastly District 5 remains focused on Santa Maria and the Santa Maria Valley, solidify that community's cohesiveness. All of this accomplished with in the federal voting rights act and conforming to the demographic profile requirements.

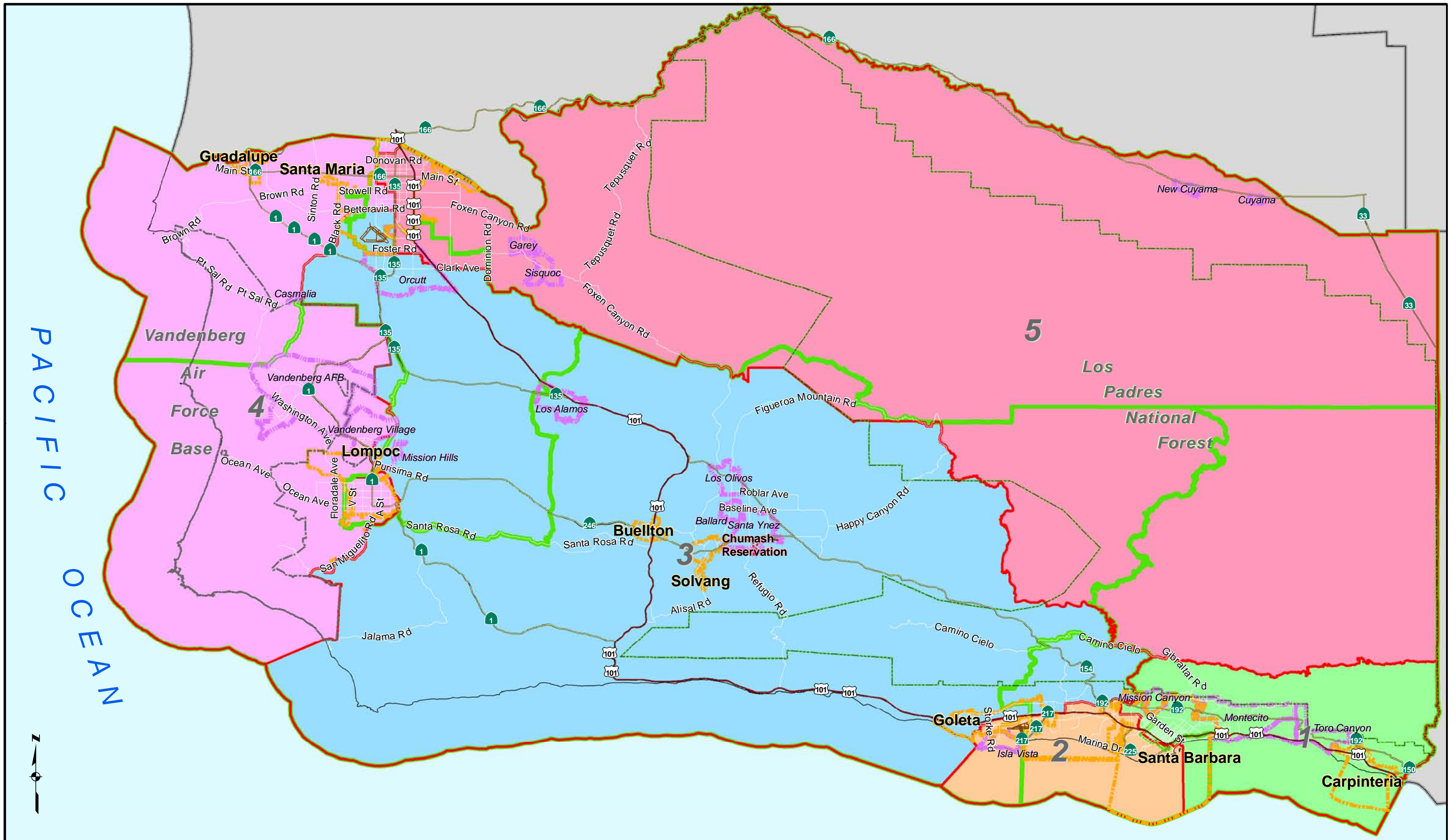

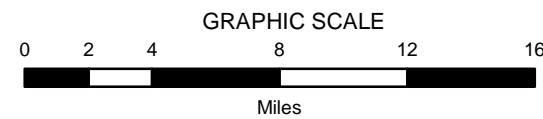

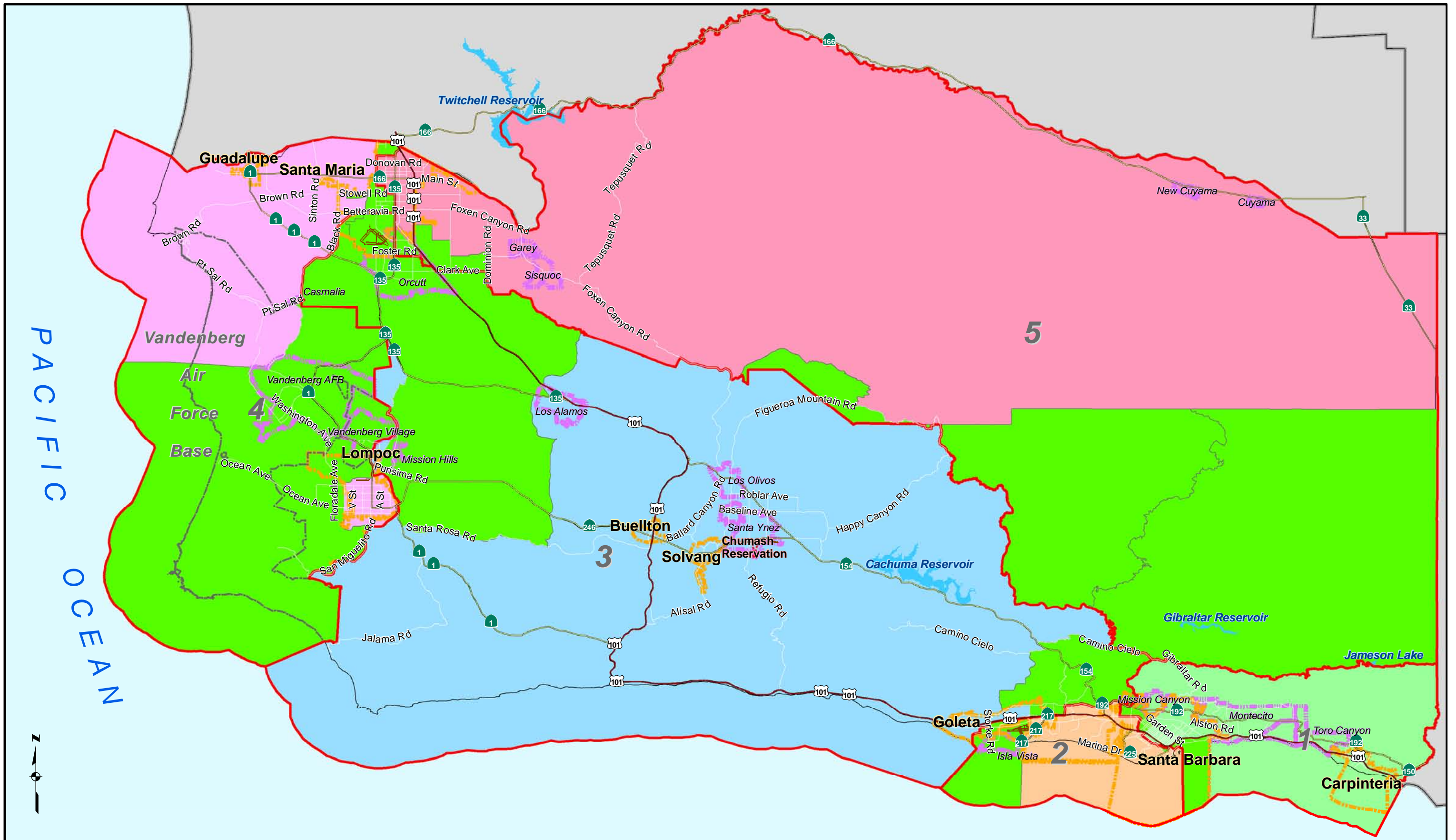
Supervisorial Districts, Santa Barbara County
Larner Plan 2 Overview

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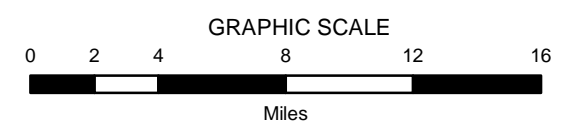
