That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Adopt the attached Resolution to rescind oversized vehicle restrictions and to establish oversized vehicle restrictions between 10:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. in the First and Second Supervisorial Districts:
- b) Find that the proposed actions are for the operation and maintenance of an existing public facility, involving negligible, or no expansion of use beyond that which presently exists, that the proposed action is therefore exempt from California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c), and approve and direct staff to file the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to rescind portions of Resolution 25-100 passed at the Board Hearing on May 13, 2025, for restricting oversized vehicles on various roads in Santa Barbara County and to reestablish time previous overnight restrictions of oversized vehicles on certain roads in Santa Barbara County.

Discussion:

Staff recommends rescinding portions of Resolution 25-100. This action will modify the restriction of parking of oversized vehicles in the areas of Butterfly Beach area of Montecito, First Supervisorial District, and Isla Vista, Second Supervisorial District, from all times to the hours between 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.

Background:

Pursuant to County Code 23-11 and permitted by California Vehicle Code Sections 22507 and 22507.5, the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, may regulate vehicle parking on certain streets or highways, or portions thereof, during all or certain hours of the day.

On May 13, 2025, your Board passed Resolution 25-100 which established oversized vehicle parking restrictions on various County roads. After the passing of the Resolution, the County was contacted by citizens concerning impacts to the community of Isla Vista. The expressed concerns are the restrictions would prevent services and deliveries that require large vehicles or prevent coastal access for people with oversized vehicles. Staff considered the issues of the citizens and recommends your Board approve the attached proposed Resolution which will modify the times of the restrictions from all times to overnight, 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. The attached resolution also specifies that vehicles being used for delivery, construction, utility work, or public transit would be exempt from the restriction. This action will address the concerns of preventing delivery, construction, or transit vehicles from accessing Isla Vista or coastal access for people with oversized vehicles but still address the original concern of oversized vehicles being stored in Isla Vista. Staff is also recommending reducing the hours of oversized parking restrictions from all times to 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. in the Butterfly Beach area of Montecito. This will address the coastal access issue for the Butterfly Beach Area.

Montecito - First Supervisorial District

Public Works recommends that your Board adopt the proposed parking restriction of oversized vehicles between the hours of 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. in the First Supervisorial District (Vicinity Map #1) on the following roads:

- •OLIVE MILL ROAD, from Spring Road to Hill Road.
- CHANNEL DRIVE, from Olive Mill Road to Fairway Road.
- •HILL ROAD, from Butterfly Lane to Olive Mill Road.
- •BUTTERFLY LANE, from Channel Drive to Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way.

Isla Vista - Second Supervisorial District

Public Works recommends that your Board adopt the proposed parking restriction of oversized vehicle between the hours of 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. in the Second Supervisorial District (Vicinity Map #2) on the following roads:

- •CAMINO CORTO, from El Colegio Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •CAMINO DEL SUR, from El Colegio Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •CAMINO PESCADERO, from El Colegio Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •EMBARCADERO DEL MAR, from El Colegio Road to Trigo Road.
- •EMBARCADERO DEL NORTE, from El Colegio Road to Trigo Road.
- •EL EMBARCADERO ROAD, from Trigo Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •FORTUNA LANE, from Fortuna Road to its northern terminus.

- •CAMINO LINDO, from Fortuna Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •CAMINO MAJORCA, from Pasado Road to Del Playa Drive.
- •DEL PLAYA DRIVE, from Camino Majorca to its eastern terminus.
- •EL NIDO LANE, from El Embarcadero Road to Sabado Tarde Road.
- •SABADO TARDE ROAD, from Camino Majorca to El Nido Lane.
- •TRIGO ROAD, from Camino Majorca to its eastern terminus.
- •SEVILLE ROAD, from Embarcadero Del Norte to its eastern terminus.
- •SEVILLE ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to Embarcadero Del Mar.
- MADRID ROAD, from Embarcadero Del Norte to its eastern terminus.
- •MADRID ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to Embarcadero Del Mar.
- PARDALL ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- CORDOBA ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- •SEGOVIA ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- •PICASSO ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- •EL GRECO ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- •CERVANTES ROAD, from Camino Pescadero to its eastern terminus.
- PICASSO ROAD, from Camino Del Sur to Camino Pescadero.
- •ABREGO ROAD, from Camino Corto to Camino Pescadero.
- •ESTERO ROAD, from Camino Corto to its eastern terminus.
- •SUENO ROAD, from Camino Corto to Camino Pescadero.
- •FORTUNA ROAD, from Camino Corto to it western terminus.
- PASADO ROAD, from Camino Majorca to Camino Pescadero.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The cost associated with installation of parking restrictions signs is variable and demand-based, but staff estimate an annual cost of \$5,000 to order, install, and maintain signs related to this issue. Funds for the projects are budgeted in Dept 054, Fund 0015, Org Unit 0500, Program 2340, Account Line Item 7121.
